The task of Think-Trust Coordination Action is to provide concrete, practicable ***Recommendations*** on:

## 1. Future Research Agenda

Identify R&D that facilitates a trustworthy Information Society that respects the privacy of its citizens, with due attention given to ICT infrastructures, networks, services and applications.

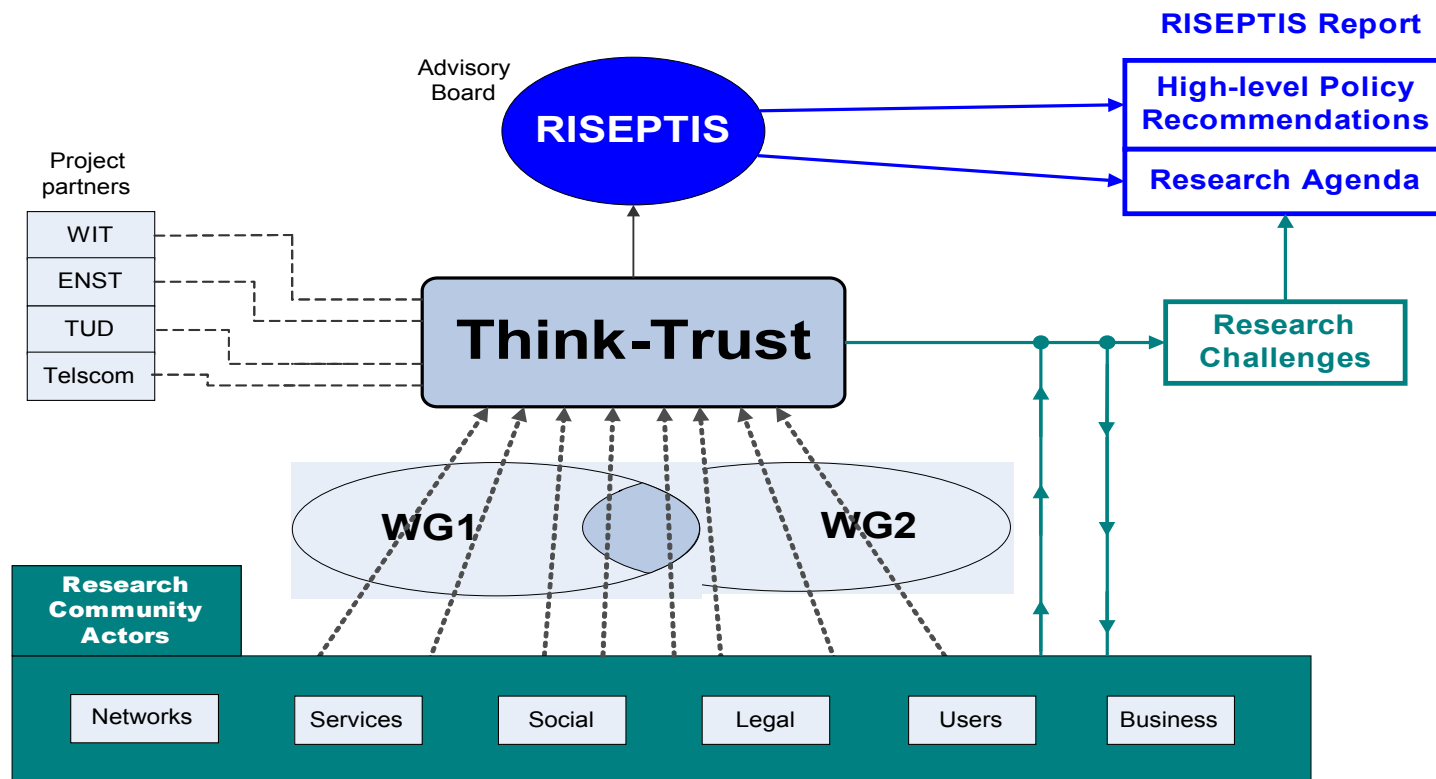
## 2. Policy Environment

Map out and model user needs, expectations and behaviour, relating to trust, security, and privacy, as part of the development of a robust legal/administrative framework for ICT operational environments.



# Project Methodology

Think-Trust will achieve these goals through an Advisory Board (**RISEPTIS: *Research & Innovation for SEcurity, Privacy & Trustworthiness in the Information Society***) and the two supporting Working Groups (**WG1, WG2** – drawn from the wider research community).
